

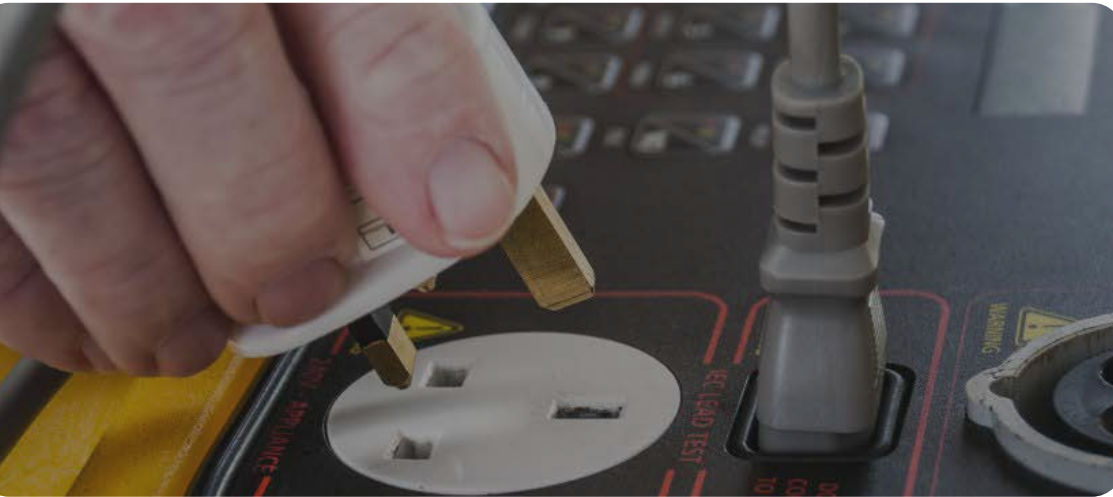

Do I need to carryout Portable Appliance Testing?

The 'Electricity at Work Regulations' of 1989 requests a 'duty of care' on landlords and employers to maintain electrical systems to prevent danger, along with licensing authorities, insurance companies and mortgage lenders, all now requesting up to date compliant copies of this report for guarantee and cover.

Insurance companies expect you to comply with Health & Safety to make sure your policy is not regarded as void. You will need to maintain your electrical appliances to a satisfactory level. Regular PAT testing will provide you with a certificate to prove you are carrying out these tests in order to comply.

How frequently do I need to test my appliances?

Unlike other companies, Ayjay Group do not just test all items of equipment every year unnecessarily, we understand that the frequency of inspection and testing depends upon the type of equipment and the environment it is used in. This understanding will save you money on tests being carried out to equipment unnecessarily every year.

What if an item fails?

Any item that does not successfully pass the test will either be repaired there and then or flagged up and identified to the relevant person(s) in change with the reason for the fail. If the item is deemed dangerous it will immediately be decommissioned from use.
